



Feeder Installation Instructions:

- 1. Find optimal location for feeder Placement**
 - a. Ideal locations will contain:
 - i. Area where at least two sides can be placed against escape cover
 - ii. Easy access for feed refilling
 - iii. Soft soil
- 2. Prepare ground for feeder placement**
 - a. Clear and level ground in 40"x 40" square
 - i. Tip: A rake and hoe usually make easy work of this step
 - ii. If the ground is exceptionally hard, a rototiller may be required
- 3. Set your Quail Safe feeder**
 - a. Place door away from escape cover for ease of opening
 - b. Ensure unit is level
- 4. Place soil on top of the floor through door**
 - a. Place soil so that the floor is uniformly covered by at least 1" of soil
 - b. Soil should cover bottom angle so that it is level with bottom of entrance holes
- 5. Install hopper and feed plate**
 - a. Handle on slide plate should face upwards
 - b. Feed plate can be easily removed for cleaning by sliding slide plate towards you just enough to be able to slide feed plate out
- 6. Fill with feed / slide hopper in / close door**

You have now successfully installed the Quail Safe
